Summary

The *Report Card for Illinois Infrastructure* is released every four years and is designed to educate lawmakers, the media, and the public about the vital role infrastructure plays in our state. A panel of civil engineers throughout the State assign grades according to the following seven criteria: capacity, condition, funding, future need, operation and maintenance, public safety, and resilience. Using a simple A to F school report card format, the 2018 Report Card will provide a comprehensive assessment of current infrastructure conditions and needs and make recommendations for how to raise the grades. Much like the 2014 Report Card, ASCE plans on providing policymakers and decision-makers with recommendations to improve the overall health of our infrastructure and improve the quality of life for Illinois’ residents, businesses and commerce.

The event will feature brief presentations by dignitaries from area public agencies, including elected officials, and a presentation of the 2018 Report Card.
