



American Society of Civil Engineers Illinois Section 2022 Scholarship Application Instructions

The Illinois Section American Society of Civil Engineers (ISASCE) & Technical Institutes are pleased to invite Illinois Section university students to apply for this year's scholarships. Detailed descriptions, eligibility requirements, award selection criteria, and application instructions are included below.

- **ASCE Student Leadership & Involvement Scholarship**
 - **One** \$1,000 award for an undergraduate or graduate student in a current, active leadership role in their ASCE student chapter with a strong interest in continued ASCE involvement after graduation.
- **Construction Institute (CI) Scholarship**
 - **Two** \$1,000 awards for undergraduate or graduate students taking relevant elective courses or indicating strong interest in construction management or construction engineering.
- **Environmental and Water Resources Institute (EWRI) Scholarship**
 - **Two** \$1,000 awards for undergraduate or graduate students taking relevant elective courses or indicating strong interest in environmental engineering or water resources engineering.
- **Geo-Institute (GI) Scholarship**
 - **Two** \$1,500 awards for undergraduate or graduate students taking relevant elective courses or indicating strong interest in geotechnical engineering, geology, geo-environmental engineering or foundation engineering.
- **Structural Engineering Institute (SEI) Scholarship**
 - **Three** \$1,500 awards for undergraduate or graduate students taking relevant elective courses or indicating strong interest in structural engineering or architectural engineering.
- **Transportation & Development Institute (T&DI) Bob Camillone Memorial Scholarship**
 - **Two** \$2,000 awards for undergraduate or graduate students taking relevant elective courses or indicating strong interest in transportation engineering, drainage, urban planning, structural engineering, or geotechnical engineering.
- **Urban Planning and Development (UP&D) Scholarship**
 - **One** \$1,000 award for an undergraduate student taking relevant courses or indicating strong interest in civil engineering.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS. Candidates shall meet the requirements below.

1. Active ASCE membership status with a valid Membership ID Number.
2. Currently pursuing a degree in an ABET-accredited undergraduate or graduate civil engineering or related program per the scholarship(s) for which they are applying.
3. Enrolled at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC), Northwestern University (NU), or Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT). Students from other schools may apply if they have an immediate family member who is a current active member of IL Section ASCE with a valid Membership ID Number.
4. Scheduled to be a full-time student for the Fall 2022 term or expected to graduate after August 2022.
5. Scholarship recipients will be asked to attend the IS-ASCE President-Elect Student Scholarship Dinner and provide a photo for recognition on ISASCE social media, newsletters, and other publications. At this time, IS-ASCE plans to return to hosting an in-person Scholarship Dinner in 2022 which is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, April 14th at Maggiano's Little Italy, 516 N Clark St, Chicago, IL. Additional details will be provided upon confirmation of award winners.
6. Previous Illinois Section ASCE & Technical Institute Scholarship recipients are not eligible.

- Academic Performance
- Work experience, community involvement, and other extracurricular activities
- Essay Response
- Two Letters of Recommendation

- All application items shall be submitted in PDF format (preferably 1 combined PDF) via email to illinoissection@isasce.org.
- The email subject line should read "**2022 ISASCE Scholarship Application – Applicant Name**".
- Application PDF submittals shall include the following 6 items, in order:
 1. **Completed 2022 Scholarship Application Form** (*see attached application form*)
 2. **Essay** (*see attached application form*)
 3. **Two letters of recommendation** (*see attached application form*)
 4. **Current résumé**, including work experience, community activities, and extracurriculars.
 5. A current, **unofficial academic transcript** with course titles, grades and cumulative GPA.
 6. A list of **registered (or anticipated) coursework for Fall 2022** (and/or Summer 2022) term
